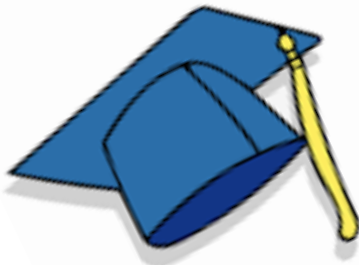
Dear Queen of All Saints Families,

Every six years, schools in the Diocese of Oakland undergo a dual accreditation process through the Western Catholic Educational Association (WCEA) and Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC). In 2014-2015, Queen of All Saints completed the accreditation process and received a 6-year accreditation, the highest ranking a school can receive. Our next accreditation review begins in 2019-2020 and will be complete in the 2020-2021 school year. In preparation for this event, we are asking for your help. Your thoughts and feedback provided on a school improvement survey will assist us as we begin the accreditation process.

You will receive the Google Forms survey of 12 short questions today via email. The responses are anonymous, and will be combined and summarized for the accreditation report. Paper copies of the survey will be available in the school office if you have difficulty accessing it online, or if you feel more comfortable mailing your responses to the school. I thank you in advance for your cooperation and support as we work together in the school improvement and accreditation process.

**Jesus Prays for All Believers**
