Baptism Sponsor Sorm

A sponsor for the Sacrament of Baptism is:

- A Roman Catholic who has received the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation;
- A person who participates in the spiritual life of the Catholic Church by weekly attendance at Sunday Mass and regular reception of the sacraments;
- A person who will share, support, and help deepen a Christian relationship with the child being baptized as the child grows and develops;
- If married, their marriage is recognized as valid by the Catholic Church;
- A person at least 16 years of age.

Please note: One of the sponsors (godparents) for Baptism may be a non-Catholic Christian, **however**, they <u>must</u> be baptized in a Christian religion and provide proof of baptism. They will be recognized as a Christian Witness to the baptism. Non-baptized persons <u>cannot</u> be godparents since they cannot profess faith in Christ, nor can they renew the vows of their own baptism.
