The *Grateful for Our Past...Preparing for Our Future* campaign will allow the diocese to augment existing endowments for preparing our future priests and priest retirement, and to establish a new endowment for youth formation. An Endowment is a fairly simple concept. The principal, revenues placed in such a fund, remains untouched with only the earnings on its investments used to address stated needs. Prudent stewardship dictates that we take care of the gifts entrusted to us today, as well as prepare for their preservation in future years. The endowment funds will:

- Generate earnings to address needs of the areas outlined; the principal of the endowment funds will not be touched;
- Grow through future gifts and contributions;
- Be managed by professional investment managers and monitored by the Diocesan Finance Council and the Investment Committee; and
- Operate under the responsibility of the Bishop of the Diocese of Springfield-Cape Girardeau.
