## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:

The concept of sacrifice is not too popular today. Perhaps we focus on it a bit more during the Season of Lent but beyond that we don't think much about giving anything up for the benefit of others. While Jesus observed those contributing to the treasury, he notices some were putting in large sums. They were not giving out a sense of generosity but rather to be noticed. A poor widow contributes a small amount yet she gives not from her surplus but from all that she had. Her contribution is much more valuable in the Lord's eyes than the larger amounts given by the others. Jesus challenges us today to reflect on how willing we are to make sacrifices. He invites us to be generous not simply financially, but to give of our time and talent as well. He asks us to give the greatest gift we have which is the gift of ourselves.

November 11<sup>th</sup> is Veterans' Day. This year marks the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the end of World War I. It is a time for us to honor all those who have served and are serving today in the military. We thank them for their service to our country and for giving of themselves that we might live in freedom and peace. We prayerfully remember in a special way all those who died protecting the freedoms that too often we take for granted.
