Dear Parishioners,

In 1950, with the infallible authority of the papacy, Pope Pius XII declared some truths about the Assumption to be certainly known. The fact of the Assumption was true before 1950, and indeed Pope Pius XII only taught what the Church has received from Jesus and has been clarified by the Holy Spirit active in the Church. Back in the 700's, St. Germanus, Patriarch of Constantinople, wrote of the Assumption: It is time... to take you to be with me, you, my mother. Just as you filled the earth and its people with joy, so now you shall bring joy to the heavens, bring happiness to the mansions of my Father... Where I am there is light eternal, joy without compare, a palace without equal, a city safe from ruin. Where I am, you shall also be. Mother inseparable in her inseparable Son.

This week, we observe the Assumption as a Holy Day of Obligation — making every effort to attend Mass AND dedicate the day to God's praise. See you in Church!

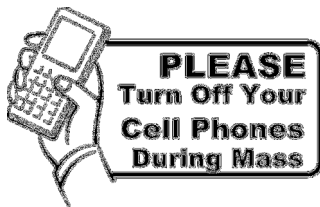
