We have a simple plan for a special observation of the 100th anniversary of Mary's final appearance at Fatima and the famous miracle of the sun. At Holy Cross on Sunday October 15, following the 11:30 Mass, the Women of St. Helena and the Knights of Columbus will co-host a meet and greet with refreshments sufficient to dispel the pangs of hunger. Around 12:45, some of the Dead Theologian Society members will carry a statue of Mary in procession while others lead the rosary. 4th Degree Knights will provide an honor guard for our Lady. Seats will be in place for the needy.

And on a different topic, this week the priests of the diocese will be on retreat in North Carolina. I will celebrate the regular 12:15 daily Masses at Holy Cross on Monday and Friday.
