Dear Parishioners,

Have you taken part in the special services of Holy Week — specifically the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday evening and the Passion Service on Good Friday afternoon? Please come to these if you can as well as the 6:30 AM "Tenebrae" services at Holy Cross on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday mornings.

Many people travel for Easter — I strongly suggest you call their church office or check out their website for Easter Mass schedules. On Holy Saturday, no Mass is permitted in daylight — not even at dusk! Our Vigil Mass is at Holy Cross, starting at 8:30 PM. This year we will have the fewest possible readings and no Baptisms. I expect the Mass to be approximately 1 hour 45 minutes. Traditionally, no blessings or sacraments are offered from Holy Thursday evening through the Easter Vigil.

Watch for a flocknote, or check out our website for information about our parish retreat, "Consoling the Heart of Jesus" starting April 4 at St Luke and April 8 at Holy Cross. This is the retreat following "33 Days to Morning Glory" which was very popular at our parishes two years ago. **It will involve one meeting each Wednesday at St. Luke or Sunday at Holy Cross and 15 to 27 pages of reading on your own during the week.** If you can't make the movie meeting, you can watch these online using "[Formed.org](http://Formed.org)".

**Also, I encourage you to sign up for the flocknote group for the Divine Mercy Novena — starting Good Friday.** If you have any trouble signing up, email the parish office.

I pray that your Lenten observance has prepared you for a peaceful Holy Week and a joyful Easter!

**Marriage:** Those contemplating marriage should contact the office at least EIGHT months prior to the wedding date to schedule an appointment with the priest.

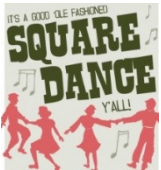
