Dear Parishioners,

Formal addresses are sometimes used on letters and envelopes — and there is an interesting difference for Deacons John and Jimmy. Deacon John is a “permanent deacon”, meaning that he will not be ordained a priest. Deacon Jimmy is a “transitional deacon”, meaning that — God willing — he will be ordained a priest next year. At that time, he will be formally addressed as “Reverend Father Jimmy Touzeau”. For now, he is “Reverend Mister Jimmy Touzeau.” On the other hand, deacon John is formally addressed as “Deacon John Villano”. Similarly, Deacon Jimmy wears black clerical clothing, while Deacon John wears grey with an embroidered symbol indicating the diaconate.

Please continue to pray for Jimmy as he begins his final 12 months of preparation for ordination to the priesthood. Since 1992 when I started preparing to be a priest of this diocese, there has been a significant decline in the number of priests available for vacation coverage. When I can find a priest available for coverage, I need to take vacation even on short notice — which is the case this year! Sunday I head to Missouri and my favorite river, and will be back for Fathers’ day weekend.

As always, to request the anointing of the sick, please call 864-897-7980. When I am in town, the call goes to me as fast as possible. When I am out of town, the staff gets the call!
