Dear Parishioners,

Suppose your child asks you to help him sell lemonade, and next tells you that he will put your picture upside down in a drawer until you cave in. How would you describe this picture ploy? Does this seem like a suitable practice for children? Would you encourage your nieces and nephews to do this?
