## HOW TO REPORT ALLEGATIONS OF SEXUAL ABUSE

### REPORT IMMEDIATELY!

**REMEMBER: YOUR ROLE IS TO REPORT. THERE IS TO BE NO INVESTIGATION BY YOU OR ANYONE ELSE AT THE PARISH/SCHOOL LEVEL**

**If you suspect abuse has occurred within a family:**

Contact the Department of Social Services within the county the abuse took place.

Contact the Diocese, to report status at (843) 261-0430.

**If you suspect an abuse has occurred that involved diocesan personnel (priests, deacons, teachers, employees or volunteers) contact:**

The local police department immediately.

Dear Parishioners,

As we pray for the dead during November, we should keep our focus on Christ, and being His friend when we die. We can fall into habits of sin, and we will if we do not guard our actions carefully. Confession is the encounter with God given by Jesus that will restore us to friendship with Christ.

The anointing of the sick is closely related to the sacrament of confession. We should request the anointing of the sick when we know that we are in danger of death from old age or a sickness that, untreated, can lead to death. When possible, we should go to confession before receiving the anointing. If not possible, we should go to confession as soon as possible afterward.

Some fitting times for the elderly to go to confession and request the anointing: prior to surgery; when moving into a retirement community or assisted living; when moving to a nursing home. Most definitely, we should make a good confession and request the anointing as soon as hospice begins to care for us. These preparations will allow us to be ready to meet God whenever He calls us from this life to Himself.

The Church has a special form of the anointing for people at the point of death. This form includes the "Apostolic Pardon", and will be most effective for Catholics who have been seeking holiness and asking for the forgiveness of sin all along.

Please help inform family and friends of these practices, and encourage each other to participate in the Church's full sacramental life.
