HOW TO REPORT ALLEGATIONS OF SEXUAL ABUSE

REPORT IMMEDIATELY!

REMEMBER: YOUR ROLE IS TO REPORT. THERE IS TO BE NO INVESTIGATION BY YOU OR ANYONE ELSE AT THE PARISH/SCHOOL LEVEL

If you suspect abuse has occurred within a family:

Contact the Department of Social Services within the county the abuse took place.

Contact the Diocese, to report status at (843) 261-0430.

If you suspect an abuse has occurred that involved diocesan personnel (priests, deacons, teachers, employees or volunteers) contact:

The local police department immediately.

Dear Parishioners,

Christmas decorations are a wonderful tradition, and are fitting from December 24th through February 2nd — the Presentation of the Lord. During Advent, we should be preparing for — not beginning — Christmas celebrations.

Every day of Advent features unique prayers for the Mass, and the “Collect” is a great prayer for everyone to use during their daily prayer. Sign up for the FlockNote email group “Advent Prayers” to get this prayer emailed to you every morning of Advent, along with a short reflection I will prepare. If you have any trouble joining this group, just call or email the church office and our staff will help you.

On the Fridays of Advent, we will be having Eucharistic Adoration with daytime prayer at Holy Cross, usually after Mass. At St. Luke, we will have Adoration and evening prayer from 6:00 to 8:00 pm. During much of this time, I will be available for confession. The first Friday of Advent will be slightly different to allow Masses for the Immaculate Conception.

I hope that you will take advantage of these two ways to make Advent a peaceful and prayerfully preparation for Christmas.

Baptism: Parents must complete training prior to having a child baptized. Please call the parish office to schedule a meeting with the Pastor.

Marriage: Those contemplating marriage should contact the office at least EIGHT months prior to the wedding date to schedule an appointment with the priest.
