Bishop Guglielmone will be at St. Mary's Church of Greenville on Tuesday, January 29th, at 7:00 pm to discuss efforts in the diocese to prevent the abuse of minors and vulnerable adults. He will be available to answer questions. If you have any questions or concerns, please attend and hear straight from our bishop.

February 1st is the first Friday, and as customary we will have a time of Eucharistic Adoration at the end of the 12:15 Mass at Holy Cross, ending at 1:30. I encourage everyone to join in prayer for Pope Francis and the bishops of the world who will be gathering in late February to address the abuse crisis in our Church. Even if you cannot make it to church that day, please, join us in prayer.

The appeal of 2018 was yet another success as a whole, and both Holy Cross and St. Luke exceeded our goals. Thank God for all the blessings we have received, and for the spirit of generosity.

The facilities of St. Luke are available to all ACTIVE parishioners. This includes the use of the church for Baptism, Weddings and other Sacramental events. Active Membership is determined as follows:

1. Registered in the parish for 6 months.
2. Faithful attendance at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days.
3. Financial support of the church according to your means.

Baptism: Parents must complete training prior to having a child baptized. Please call the parish office to schedule a meeting with the Pastor.

Marriage: Those contemplating marriage should contact the office at least EIGHT months prior to the wedding date to schedule an appointment with the priest.
