## HOW TO REPORT ALLEGATIONS OF SEXUAL ABUSE

### REPORT IMMEDIATELY!

**REMEMBER: YOUR ROLE IS  
TO REPORT. THERE IS TO BE  
NO INVESTIGATION BY YOU  
OR ANYONE ELSE AT THE  
PARISH/SCHOOL LEVEL**

**If you suspect abuse has occurred  
within a family:**

Contact the Department of  
Social Services within the  
county the abuse took place.

Contact the Diocese, to report  
status at (843) 261-0430.

**If you suspect an abuse has  
occurred that involved  
diocesan personnel (priests,  
deacons, teachers, employees  
or volunteers) contact:**

The local police department

Dear Parishioners,

It's that time of year again, when bishops across the country ask the Catholics in their dioceses to support their annual fundraising drives of assorted names. Since my time in South Carolina, the drive has been called "Diocesan Development Fund", "Bishop's Stewardship Appeal", and currently the "Bishop's Annual Appeal", the "BAA". Each name has reflected a slightly different reason that money is needed, but the simple fact is that many activities necessary for the Church's mission require money.

A solid seminary education is necessary for well-educated and prepared priests. For most men who have already graduated college, seminary begins with two years of undergraduate college studies of philosophy and religion at a "college" seminary. Four years of graduate studies follow at a "major" seminary. To say these "are not cheap" is an understatement! People who have donated in the past usually receive a packet in the mail explaining many other programs funded by the BAA. We have a few of these available at the Church entrance.

It is good for us to support these programs through the BAA. I am glad to be able to report that our parishes have increased total funds raised for the appeal, and also a higher percentage of parishioners have been supporting the appeal. These two facts mean we don't have to interrupt our Sunday Masses with presentations by people and videos. If you want to watch the video, you can see it from the parish website or we'll lend you the dvd.

If you have been supporting this appeal, I trust that you will continue to do so. If you have not supported the appeal in the past, I ask you to consider in prayer whether or not you can. God blesses generous givers, sometimes in surprising ways; God is never outdone in generosity!

**Marriage:** Those contemplating marriage should contact the office at least EIGHT months prior to the wedding date to schedule an appointment with the priest.
