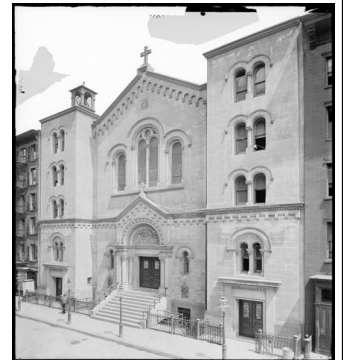
**SAN VINCENZO MARTIRE di CRA-**
