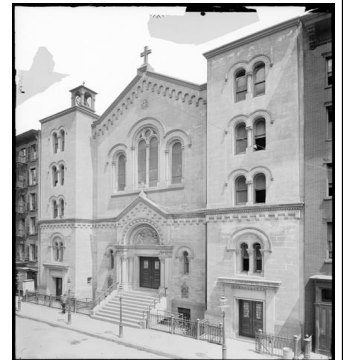

CHRISTMAS EVE MASS: There WILL be a Mass on Christmas Eve at Most Precious Blood Church. The Mass will be celebrated at 5:30PM by Father Patrick Boyle, O.F.M.



On the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, January 1st, a holy day of obligation, there will NOT be a vigil Mass on Sunday, December 31st at Most Precious Blood. However there will be Vigil Mass for the Solemnity at the Basilica of St. Patrick's Old Cathedral at 5:30 PM on Sunday, December 31. There will be no 7:00 PM Mass at the Basilica on Sunday, December 24 or 31.
