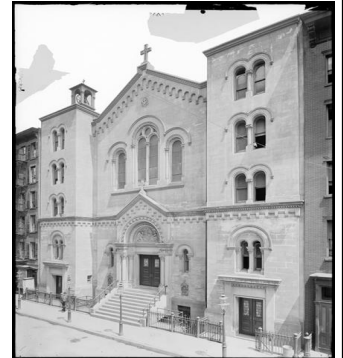

LENT: This coming Wednesday, February 14th, is Ash Wednesday which marks the beginning of the Lenten season. Ash Wednesday is a day of both fasting and abstinence; every Friday following will be a day of abstinence. **PALM SUNDAY** is on March 25th and **GOOD FRIDAY** is on March 30th. Good Friday, of course, is a day of both fasting and abstinence. We will let you know in next week's Bulletin if there will be Stations of the Cross every Friday here at Most Precious Blood Church as was done last year.



DONATIONS are being sought for both the Buongiorno Project and our Most Precious Blood Senior Citizen's Club.
