THE OBSERVANCE OF ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT ON THE FRIDAYS OF LENT

Abstinence forbids the use of meat, but not of eggs, milk products or condiments made of animal fat. Abstinence does not include meat juices and liquid foods made from meat. Thus, such foods as chicken broth, soups cooked or flavored with meat, meat gravies or sauces, as well as seasonings or condiments made from animal fat are not forbidden

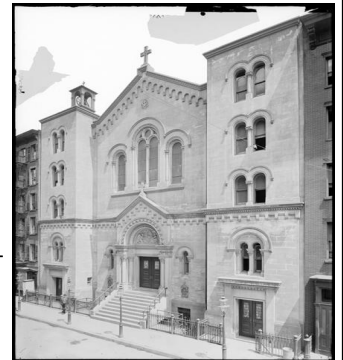

STATIONS OF THE CROSS: The Stations of the Cross devotional will be held every Wednesday after the 12:10PM Mass until Wednesday, March 28th – the last Wednesday before Good Friday. The Stations will be led by Jean Sama, one of our parishioners. We thank Jeanie for volunteering to do this for us.

SANT’EGIDIO: A reminder that the weekly prayer service by the community of Sant’Egidio has moved their ‘event’ permanently to St. Patrick’s Old Cathedral. The time of the prayer service remains the same: every Friday at 6:30PM.

SAVING BUONGIORNO AND MOST PRECIOUS BLOOD SENIOR CITIZEN’S CLUB: For the past several weeks, we have been asking for both of the above ‘causes’.
