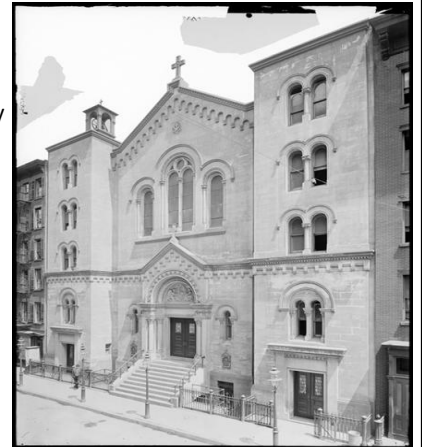

SAINT ANTHONY NOVENA:

Tuesday, May 22, will be week 10 of our Saint Anthony Novena. The novena is prayed every Tuesday immediately after the 12:10PM Mass and will continue until Tuesday, June 12th. Saint Anthony's feast day is Wednesday, June 13th, and will be celebrated at our weekly 12:10PM Wednesday Mass. Blessed Saint Anthony bread will be distributed on the feast day.



SAINT ANTHONY SOCIETY OF GIOVINAZZO ANNUAL MASS: Last year when all the societies had to vacate their rooms in our church hall due to ongoing renovations, the president of the Saint Anthony Society of Giovinazzo assured us that, although they were forced to move their monthly meetings to another church, their annual Mass in honor of Saint Anthony would be held here at Most Precious Blood as they have done for close to 70 years. Saint Anthony's feast day is almost here, and we have been getting some calls regarding the society's Mass.

After reaching out to them, we were saddened and distressed to learn that their plans have changed; they will NOT be celebrating their annual Mass here at Most Precious Blood Church. Instead of celebrating Mass at the church where their society was founded, they have decided to hold their Mass at another church in another borough. They cite too much traffic and too little parking in Little Italy as reasons why they came to this decision. It's disheartening to know that issues such as these have become more important than honoring decades-old traditions and loyalty to MPB. It is sad to have this happen at all, but our sadness is exacerbated since we are also dealing with the loss of our rectory.

We wish them well in their new 'home'.

THERE IS GOOD NEWS, TOO: The San Calogero Society has been resurrected, thanks to the ongoing efforts of Angel Marinaccio and friends. The newly-formed society already has at least 35 members. They will be celebrating their first Mass as an official society here at Most Precious Blood Church on June 16, 2018, in honor of both San Calogero and the Madonna del Soccorso di Sciacca, our newest acquisition.
