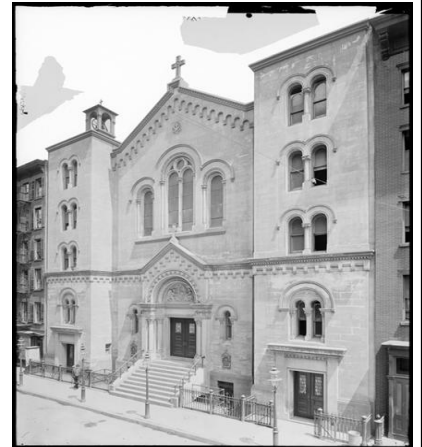

SAINT ANTHONY NOVENA:

Tuesday, June 12th, is the 13th and final novena in honor of Saint Anthony of Padua. The novena will be prayed immediately after the 12:10PM Mass. Saint Anthony’s feast day is Wednesday, June 13th, and will be celebrated at our weekly Wednesday 12:10PM Mass. Blessed Saint Anthony bread will be distributed both on the last day of the novena and at this feast day Mass.



PLEASE NOTE this also signifies the end of Tuesday Masses at Most Precious Blood. As of June 13th, weekday Mass will only be celebrated on Wednesdays at 12:10PM.

SAINT NAMES AND FEAST DAY labels have been added to our saint statues and icons. Many people admire the beautiful saints we display here at Most Precious Blood Church, but many do not know the names of the lesser-known saints. Regarding the saints everyone can recognize, more often than not people are not aware of the feast day associated with that saint. With the addition of these labels we have removed the mystery, hopefully making it easier for everyone to recognize and honor their particular beloved saint’s feast.
