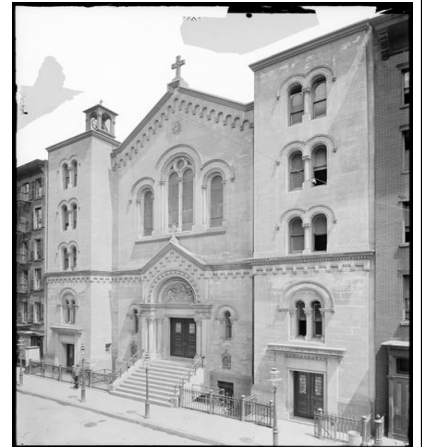

SAINT PADRE PIO:

As we mentioned last week, there will be a viewing of the relics of Saint Pio during the week of the San Gennaro Feast in September. The relics will be on display in Saint Patrick's youth center on Mulberry Street. We don't have all the details yet, but as soon as we do we will publish them here. The San Gennaro Feast begins on Thursday, September 13, 2018 and ends on Sunday, September 23, 2018.



In addition to the relics at St. Patrick's, we will be celebrating a special Mass in honor of Saint Pio here at Most Precious Blood Church. This Mass is tentatively scheduled for Saturday, September 22nd, time to be determined. NOTE: The Saint Pio Shrine in Most Precious Blood Church is in dire need of repair. There is a hole in the ceiling of the shrine where some electrical work was performed, and we were left to repair the damage. Also, half of the mirrored ceiling tiles are missing and need to be replaced. DONATIONS ARE NEEDED. A donation in whatever amount you can afford will be greatly appreciated. We hope to have the shrine ceiling repaired before the Mass for St. Pio on September 22nd.
