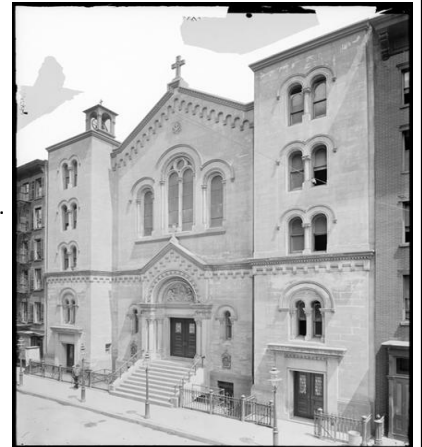

Although most of the week is behind us, there is still time to visit this wonderful celebration and the beautiful Shrine Church of the same name. If you've never witnessed the OLMC/Giglio Feast in person, you are missing out on something incredibly amazing. This feast began in 1903 when immigrants from Nola, Italy, settled in Williamsburg, Brooklyn; to say it has grown in size and devotion would be an understatement.
