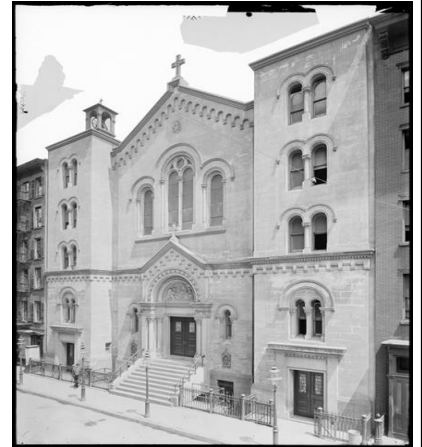

**SAN VINCENZO MARTIRE di**

**CRACO:** Today, Sunday, October 28th, is the annual Mass in honor of San Vincenzo Martire di Craco, sponsored by the Craco Society. San Vincenzo is the protector of Craco, a town in southern Italy in the Basilicata Region. As a soldier in the Theban Legion, a Christian faction of the Roman Army, Vincent and the other Theban soldiers were ordered to sacrifice themselves before the Roman Gods. As Christians, they refused to honor false gods and, ultimately, all were executed. San Vincenzo's martyred bones were brought to Craco in 1792. His feast has been celebrated there since then, and in New York City since 1901. The first celebration here was held outside Most Precious Blood Church while it was still under construction. The statue in MPB Church was made on Spring Street in Little Italy in 1901. It was originally housed in St. Joachim's Church, then moved to St. Joseph's Church before coming to Most Precious Blood in 2015. Inside the display case is a bone relic of San Vincenzo.



**SANT'ANGELO D'ACRI:** Sunday, October 28 is also the annual Mass in honor of Sant'Angelo D'Acri, sponsored by the Beato Angelo Society. Over 100 years ago, immigrants from the town of Acri, Italy, settled in New York City in search of a better life for themselves and their families. As most immigrants did, the faithful from Acri brought with them a devotion to the patron and protector of their town, Beato Angelo (Blessed Angelo). Angelo's parents were poor people but rich in faith. During a sermon by Fr. Antonio da Olivadi, Angelo felt the need for a religious vocation and entered the Cappuchin Monastery. In 1691, Angelo took his solemn vows. He completed his theological studies and was ordained a priest in 1700 in the Cappuchin Order of Franciscans. His sermons were strong and impacted the people of southern Italy. His preachings resulted in many people's conversions to Catholicism. Angelo performed miracles, a gift given to him by God. He was able to heal the sick by placing his hand on their heads. Angelo, himself, experienced a personal miracle when, after becoming blind six months before his death, he regained his sight to celebrate Mass. He died at age 70 in Acri, Italy. Angelo was beatified in 1825 and, finally, was canonized as a saint on October 15, 2017. His feast day is celebrated on the last Sunday of October.
