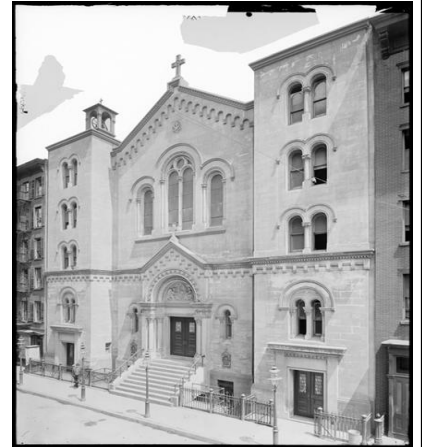

Immediately after Mass, there will be a reading of the names of World War 1 veterans in honor of the 100th Anniversary of the War’s end: November 11, 1918.

VETERAN’S DAY: November 11, 2018, is traditionally the day we celebrate Veteran’s Day, a day set aside to honor all United States veterans who served our country in the past and all active-duty troops currently serving around the world. This year, Sunday, November 11th, marks the 100th Anniversary of the end of World War 1 which ended on the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month of that year:



November 11, 1918. To honor those veterans, immediately after our 5:30PM Mass there will be a reading of the names of local veterans who served during WW1. These will be veterans from Little Italy and surrounding neighborhoods. We will have light refreshments at the back of the church which will conclude the ‘event’. Time is running out to have the name of your loved one or someone you know who served during this war; please submit the name(s) as early as you can this week – it will be the last chance to do so.
