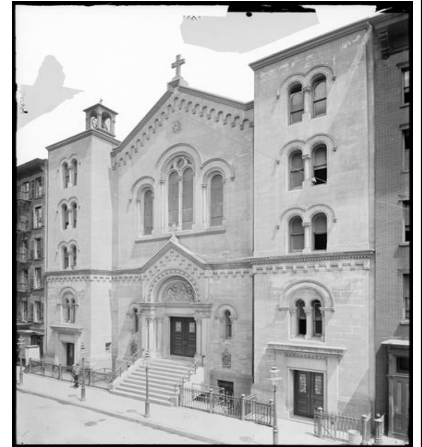

OPERATING AND CAPITAL COSTS IN CHURCHES

It is the policy of the Archdiocese of New York that parishes develop plans that enable them to operate within their means. Similar to your own home finances, the expenses of a parish, need to be met by its income. Meanwhile, you should be saving money for a the "rainy" days that inevitable come or for rehabilitation or for extraordinary needs like new furniture, appliances or a new boiler. The former are called "operating expenses" and the latter are called "capital expenses". Every parish is expected to live within its means. Therefore, the operating budget which includes expenses like lighting, heating,, cleaning, security, staff, need to be met by the Sunday collection, candles donation and gifts. On the other hand, money that is gained from the sale of church property must be considered to be the "patrimony" of the church and used only for capital needs such as the replacements of roofs, preservation of stained glass windows, replacement of boilers, improvements to physical plant etc. These capital expenses are inevitable and must be planned for carefully. If the money from the sale of property is used for operating expenses, it will be exhausted before too long and there will be no resources for addressing the very costly capital needs. In fact, in order to keep up with the effects of inflation, the best use o the capital savings of a parish, is not to use the principle but only the interest from its capital account.
