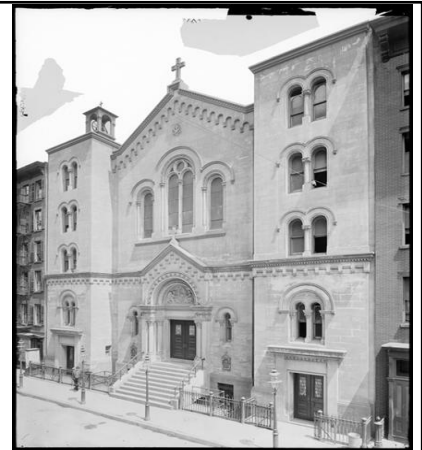

They took this as a sign, and Fabian was chosen unanimously to become the new pope. He died a martyr’s death after leading the church for 14 years.
