Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In describing what appears to be the initial day of Jesus' ministry, Mark familiarizes the readers with the type of things done in proclaiming the kingdom: teaching in the Capernaum synagogue with authority, exorcising a unclean spirit, the continued opposition of Satan, healing Simon's mother in law, healing many more diseased and possessed, and finally seeking a place to pray on the following morning, only to be importuned by his disciples pressing demands on him. Several factors should be noted. Teaching and an exercise of divine power in healing and driving out demons are united in the proclamation of the kingdom, implying that the coming of God's rule is complex. Those who claim to be God's people must recognize that some of their attitudes stand in the way and must change their minds; the presence of evil visible in human affliction, suffering and sin must be contravened; and the demonic must be defeated. Jesus can teach with authority unlike other people, and even the demons must obey him, all this is related to his being Son of God. Yet Mark never describes Jesus being given such authority and power; he simply has it because of who he is. Paradoxically the unclean spirit that opposes him recognizes that He is the Holy One of God, while the disciples who follow him do not understand him fully despite his teaching and powerful deeds.

Cuarto Domingo en el Tiempo Ordinario

Al describir lo que parece ser el día inicial del Ministerio de Jesús, Mark familiariza a los lectores el tipo de cosas que se hacen al proclamar el Reino: enseñar en la sinagoga de Capernaum con autoridad, exorcizar un espíritu impuro, la continua oposición de Satanás, la curación de la madre de Simón en la ley, la curación de muchos más enfermos y poseídos, y, finalmente, la búsqueda de un lugar para Orar en la mañana siguiente, sólo para ser importunado por sus discípulos presionando las demandas de él. Hay que señalar varios factores. La enseñanza y el ejercicio del poder divino en la curación y la expulsión de los demonios están Unidos en la proclamación del Reino, lo que implica que la venida del gobierno de Dios es compleja. Aquellos que dicen ser el pueblo de Dios deben reconocer que algunas de sus actitudes intervienen en el camino y deben cambiar sus mentes; la presencia del mal visible en la aflicción humana, el sufrimiento y el pecado deben ser infringidos; y el demonio debe ser derrotado. Jesús puede enseñar con autoridad a diferencia de otras personas, e incluso los demonios deben obedecerle, todo esto está relacionado con su ser hijo de Dios. Sin embargo, Mark nunca describe a Jesús siendo dado tal autoridad y poder; simplemente lo tiene por lo que es. Paradójicamente el espíritu impuro que se le opone reconoce que él es el Santo de Dios, mientras que los discípulos que le siguen no lo entienden plenamente a pesar de su enseñanza y sus poderosos actos.
