Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In Mark's Gospel Jesus forbids the demons to speak, because they knew him. This is the first instance of what scholars call Mark's "messianic secret", whereby Jesus seems to hide his identity as the Son of God until it is made apparent after his death on the cross. We shall comment later on scholar's detection and interpretation of the Secret, but the simplest meaning in the narrative is that demoniac knowledge of him, although it invokes a true title, does not catch the mystery of his person, which as we shall see, involves suffering and death. A struggle in Jesus' vocation between tranquil prayer and activity is glimpsed.

The expansion of Jesus' activity, Jesus ministry of preaching, driving out demons, and healing moves through the towns of Galilee, a geographical range that will be enlarged in subsequent chaps of Mark. Notice that the silence or secrecy motif is now extended to the healed leper because publicity would make it impossible for Jesus to circulate openly. Implicitly, too, enthusiasm for the wonderful could give the wrong understanding of Jesus.

Quinto Domingo en el Tiempo Ordinario

En el Evangelio de Marcos Jesús prohíbe a los demonios hablar, porque ellos lo conocían. Esta es la primera instancia de lo que los eruditos llaman el "secreto mesiánico" de Marcos, por el cual Jesús parece ocultar su identidad como el hijo de Dios hasta que se hace evidente después de su muerte en la Cruz. Comentaremos después a los eruditos la detección e interpretación del secreto, pero el significado más simple en la narrativa es que demoníaca conocimiento de él, aunque invoca un verdadero título, no atrapa el misterio de su persona, que como veremos, implica sufrimiento y muerte. Se vislumbra una lucha en la vocación de Jesús entre la oración y la actividad tranquilas.

La expansión de la actividad de Jesús, el Ministerio de predicación de Jesús, la expulsión de demonios, y la curación se mueve a través de las ciudades de Galilea, un rango geográfico que se agrandará en los siguientes capítulos de Marcos. Observe que el motivo del silencio o del secreto se extiende ahora al leproso curado porque la publicidad haría imposible que Jesús circulara abiertamente. Implícitamente, también, entusiasmo para el maravilloso podría dar la comprensión equivocada de Jesús.
