Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

First, in John chapter 6 Jesus is the Bread of Life in the sense that his revelation constitutes teaching by God, so that one must believe in the Son to have eternal life. The language: "no one who comes to me shall ever be hungry, and no one who believes in me shall ever again be thirsty", echoes the promise of Divine Wisdom in the book of Sirach. Second, in John Jesus is nourishment in another sense, for one must feed on his flesh and blood to have eternal life. The themes of chapter 6 are duplicated but now in language evocative to the Eucharist. Indeed, "the bread that I shall give is my own flesh for the life of the world", might well be the Johannine Eucharist formula comparable to "this is my body which is given for you" of Luke 22, and I Cor. 11. Taken as a whole the two parts of the discourse in John 6 would reveal that Jesus feeds his followers both through his revelation and his Eucharistic flesh and blood. In response some of Jesus' disciples murmur about his teaching even as did the Jews. On the level of Jesus' ministry this unfavorable reaction is to his claims about the heavenly origin of the Son of Man, on the level of community life it may reflect a rejection by other Christians of a high view of the Eucharist.

Decimonoveno Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

En primer lugar, en Juan capítulo 6, Jesús es el pan de vida en el sentido de que su revelación constituye la enseñanza por Dios, de modo que uno debe creer en el Hijo tiene vida eterna.

El idioma: "nadie que venga a mí jamás tendrá hambre, y nadie que crea en mí jamás volverá a tener sed", se hace eco de la promesa de la sabiduría divina en el libro de Sirach. Segundo, en Juan Jesús es alimento en otro sentido, porque uno debe alimentarse de su carne y sangre para tener vida eterna. Los temas del capítulo 6 son duplicados, pero ahora en la lengua evocadora a la eucaristía. En efecto, "el pan que daré es mi propia carne para la vida del mundo", podría estar bien la fórmula de la eucaristía Johannine comparable a "esto es mi cuerpo que dan para usted" de Luke 22, y I Cor. 11. Tomadas como un todo, las dos partes del discurso en Juan 6 revelarían que Jesús alimenta a sus seguidores a través de su revelación y de su carne y sangre eucarísticas. En respuesta, algunos de los discípulos de Jesús murmuran acerca de su enseñanza, incluso como lo hicieron los judíos. En el nivel del Ministerio de Jesús esta reacción desfavorable es a sus afirmaciones sobre el origen celestial del hijo del hombre, en el nivel de la vida comunitaria puede reflejar un rechazo por otros cristianos de una alta visión de la Eucaristía.
