Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Superiority of Jesus' Priesthood - The opening verse states the dominant theme: We have a High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God. Although Hebrews and John share the notion of an incarnation, we do not find in John a description of the reality of Jesus' humanity comparable to that offered by this section in Hebrews. A high priest who is able to sympathize with our weaknesses, Jesus was tested in every way as we are, yet without sin. Like the Israelite high priest Christ has not exalted himself but was appointed by God, a point illustrated by royal coronation psalms. Describing Jesus' suffering in the days of his flesh when he brought prayers and supplications to the One who had the power to save him from death, the writer affirms that Jesus learned obedience despite his being Son. These verses show familiarity with the tradition of Jesus' passion whereby he prayed to God about his impending death. When he was made perfect, he became the source of eternal salvation to all who obey him

El Trigésimo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

La superioridad del Clero de Jesús - El verso inicial declara el tema dominante: tenemos un Sumo sacerdote que ha pasado por el cielo, Jesús el Hijo de Dios. Aunque Hebreos y Juan comparten la noción de una encarnación, no encontramos en Juan una descripción de la realidad de la humanidad de Jesús comparable a la ofrecida por esta sección en Hebreos. Un sumo sacerdote que es capaz de simpatizar con nuestras debilidades, Jesús fue probado en todas las maneras que somos, pero sin pecado. Como el sumo sacerdote israelita Cristo no se ha exaltado a sí mismo, sino que fue nombrado por Dios, un punto ilustrado por los Salmos de coronación real. Describiendo el sufrimiento de Jesús en los días de su carne cuando trajo oraciones y súplicas a aquel que tenía el poder de salvarlo de la muerte, el escritor afirma que Jesús aprendió la obediencia a pesar de su hijo. Estos versos demuestran la familiaridad con la tradición de la pasión de Jesús según la cual él oró a Dios acerca de su inminente muerte. Cuando fue hecho perfecto, él se convirtió en la fuente de salvación eterna para todos los que le obedecen.
