Of particular interest is the designation of the Spirit as the Paraclete. Unlike the neuter word "pneuma" for Spirit, "parakletos" literally "the one called alongside" is a personal designation picturing a Spirit called in after Jesus' departure as "Advocate" to defend Christians and "Consoler" to comfort them. Just as Jesus received everything from the Father and while on earth is the way to know the Father in heaven, so when Jesus goes to heaven, the Paraclete who receives everything from Jesus is the way to know Jesus. Jesus however is the Divine Word incarnate in one human being whose stay in this world with his followers is temporary; the Paraclete does not become incarnate but dwells in all who love Jesus and keep his commandments and is with them forever. Two features are characteristic: He is in a hostile relationship to the world which cannot see or recognize him and he serves as a teacher explaining the implications of what Jesus said.

The latter motif appears in the second Paraclete passage of chapter 14, and then Jesus gives his gift of peace, accompanied by a warning that the prince of this world is coming. Jesus' final words in this chapter, "Get up! let us leave here and be on our way", seems to signal the end of the Last Discourse and would lead perfectly into chapter 18, "after this discourse Jesus went out with his disciples across the Kidron valley".

Sexto Domingo de Pascua

De particular interés es la designación del Espíritu como el Paráclito. A diferencia de la palabra neutra "pneuma" para Espíritu, "parakletos" literalmente "el llamado" es una designación personal que representa a un Espíritu llamado después de la partida de Jesús como "Abogado" para defender a los cristianos y "Consolador" para consolarlos. Así como Jesús recibió todo del Padre y mientras está en la tierra es la manera de conocer al Padre en el cielo, así cuando Jesús va al cielo, el Paráclito que recibe todo de Jesús es la manera de conocer a Jesús. Sin embargo, Jesús es el Verbo Divino encarnado en un ser humano cuya permanencia en este mundo con sus seguidores es temporal; el Paráclito no se encarna, sino que mora en todos los que aman a Jesús y guardan sus mandamientos y están con ellos para siempre. Dos características son características: está en una relación hostil con el mundo que no puede verlo ni reconocerlo y sirve como maestro que explica las implicaciones de lo que dijo Jesús.

El último motivo aparece en el segundo pasaje de Paraclete del capítulo 14, y Jesús les da su regalo de paz, acompañado por una advertencia de que el príncipe de este mundo está llegando. Las últimas palabras de Jesús en este capítulo, "¡Levántate! Salgamos de aquí y sigamos nuestro camino", parece indicar el final del Último Discurso y conduciría perfectamente al capítulo 18, "después de este discurso, Jesús salió con sus discípulos. a través del valle de Kidron ".
