The Diocese of Bismarck and the Cathedral welcome this special opportunity to offer for veneration a relic of this patron saint of parish priests, whose holiness and integrity are a model for clergy and laity alike. On Tuesday, May 28 Mass will be offered by Bishop Kagan at 5:30 PM. Veneration of the relic and confessions will begin after Mass and continue through the night until noon on May 29. Night Prayer will begin at 9:00 PM on May 28. On Wednesday, May 29, Mass will take place at 6:45 AM and 8:00 AM. The Divine Mercy Chaplet will be recited after the 8:00 AM Mass. A rosary will be prayed at 11:30 AM, with the Litany of Saints to follow. A closing procession will be at noon.
