Sacramental Life

Baptism

To have a child baptized, parents must register and attend a class as a couple. Sessions are held for both parishes. Please try to attend before your child is born. At least one parent and both godparents need to be practicing Catholics. If you don't attend Sunday Mass regularly, there is something you can do: Start coming to Sunday Mass. Please call or email the church office for information or to register.

Penance

The priest is available for Penance at St. Bernadette on Saturday at 3 PM and Thursday at 5:30 PM, and at St. Mary Bremen on Sunday at 8 AM. First Saturday confessions are held at 8:30 AM at St. Bernadette. Every Catholic priest is available whenever there is a need.

Anointing and Care of the Sick

The priest gives the Anointing of the Sick to one

who is dangerously ill, facing major surgery, or suffering from the ravages of old age. The priest brings Penance, Anointing, and Holy Communion to the sick or shut in. Call the parish office before a hospitalization or when it has been too long since the sacraments were last available.

Holy Matrimony

Couples wishing to marry should contact the parish office six months before a wedding. Why so long? Because this sacrament, not just the ceremony, requires serious preparation. And the Church needs to be involved in that preparation. The Church needs to support couples through the years of married life and offers programs to enhance married life. To learn about these programs, watch the bulletin.

Eucharistic Adoration takes place each Wednesday at St. Bernadette with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 9 AM and Benediction and Reposition at 1 PM. All are welcome.

Missionary Appeal

Father Ferdinand Lukoa, a Salvatorian (Society of the Divine Savior) priest, will visit our parishes on August 18 and 19 as part of the Missionary Cooperation Plan of the Columbus diocese. Salvatorians strive to “make the Savior known through all ways and means”. There are 3,100 Salvatorians in 45 countries on 6 continents, one of which is Fr. Lukoa’s homeland of Tanzania in Africa. Salvatorians work and worship with the people they help; they feed the hungry, provide health services, give pastoral help, and even care for livestock. In a continent where struggle and violence is often the only story that the world hears, Salvatorians are showing, through their call to proclaim the good news, that the story of Africa is a sign of hope for all of us. Commenting on his travels in the United States, Father Lukoa said, “. . . Despite the diversity and how big this country is, her people are similar to those in my homeland. Our sharing of stories makes us feel united and connected as one Church! Our visions and dreams are alike. They just come from different perspectives.”
