Sacramental Life

Baptism

To have a child baptized, parents must register and attend a class as a couple. Try to attend before your child is born. At least one parent and godparent must be practicing Catholics. Please call or email the church office for information or to register.

Confession

The priest is available for Penance at St. Bernadette on Saturday at 3 PM and Thursday at 5:30 PM, and at St. Mary Bremen on Sunday at 8 AM. First Saturday Confessions are held at 8:30 AM at St. Bernadette. Every Catholic priest is available whenever there is a need.

Anointing and Care of the Sick

The priest gives the Anointing of the Sick to one who is dangerously ill, facing major surgery, or suffering from the ravages of old age. Call the parish office before a hospitalization or when it has been too long since the Sacraments were last available.

Holy Matrimony

Couples wishing to marry should contact the parish office six months before a wedding. Why so long? Because this Sacrament, not just the ceremony, requires serious preparation. And the Church needs to be involved in that preparation. The Church needs to support couples through the years of married life and offers programs to enhance married life. To learn about these programs, watch the bulletin.

Eucharistic Adoration

Eucharistic Adoration takes place each Wednesday at St. Bernadette with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 9 AM and Benediction and Reposition at 1 PM. All are welcome.

This Thursday is a Holy Day of Obligation. Check the Mass schedule for details on this and also a special Solemn High Latin Mass to be offered for All Souls' Day. November is dedicated to all the Holy Souls in Purgatory. We encourage parishioners to arrange for Masses to be offered for their deceased loved ones. The date can be on or near an anniversary, birthday, or significant day. The available days on the parish calendar are scheduled through the office (first-come, first-reserve).

Visiting cemeteries is another usual practice during this time. Do not be afraid to take your children and tell them stories about the past, always including prayers for our loved ones. This is spiritually healthy for all of us to do! Next Saturday will be our annual Mass to remember those who have passed this year. Prayer for the dead is a Spiritual Work of Mercy to which we are all obligated, but it is a great source of consolation for us as well. The traditional prayer is: "Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen. May their souls and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen" Furthermore, did you know that you can plan ahead for yourself? Our office can help prepare for as much or as little as you'd like with pre-arrangements.

An Unusual Mass Schedule

This week, Sunday through Wednesday, October 28 through October 31, Masses are scheduled as usual. But then comes All Saints' Day, on Thursday, November 1,

which is a holy day of obligation; All Souls' Day on Friday, November 2, which is not obligatory, but on which priests and congregations are urged to make a special effort to attend Mass (and First Friday as well, which is the Church's special monthly day to honor the Sacred Heart of Jesus); and First Saturday on Saturday, November 3, which is the monthly special day of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

On Thursday we will celebrate Holy Day Mass

- at 8:20 AM and 6 PM at St. Bernadette and
- at NOON at St. Mary Bremen.

On Friday we will celebrate Mass for the faithful departed

- at 8:20 AM at St. Bernadette and at 6 PM with a Latin Mass at St. Bernadette

On this First Friday we will also have our usual devotions to the Sacred Heart.

On Saturday morning, November 3, we will celebrate First Saturday Mass at 9 AM (as usual) at St. Bernadette and on Saturday evening, Mass will be at the usual time at St. Bernadette, but with the parish's tradition of beginning the Month of the Faithful Departed with a Mass of Remembrance, commemorating at Mass parishioners who have died during the preceding year.
