## Sacramental Life

### Baptism

To have a child baptized, parents must register and attend a class as a couple. Try to attend before your child is born. At least one parent and godparent must be practicing Catholics. Please call or email the church office for information or to register.

### Confession

The priest is available for Penance at St. Bernadette on Saturdays at 8:30 AM and 3 PM, and on Thursdays at 5:30 PM. Confessions are held at St. Mary Bremen on Sunday at 8 AM. Every Catholic priest is available whenever there is a need.

### Anointing and Care of the Sick

The priest gives the Anointing of the Sick to one who is dangerously ill, facing major surgery, or suffering from the ravages of old age. Call the parish office before a hospitalization or when it has been too long since the Sacraments were last available.

### Holy Matrimony

Couples wishing to marry should contact the parish office six months before a wedding. Why so long? Because this Sacrament, not just the ceremony, requires serious preparation. And the Church needs to be involved in that preparation. The Church needs to support couples through the years of married life and offers programs to enhance married life. To learn about these programs, watch the bulletin.

### Eucharistic Adoration

Eucharistic Adoration takes place each Wednesday at St. Bernadette with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 9 AM and Benediction and Reposition at 1 PM. All are welcome and encouraged to come.



## Both Parishes

### Collar Corner

The holiest week of the year is upon us. Blessed Palm Sunday! Don't throw away last year's blessed palms – bring them to the office and we will burn them for ashes for Ash Wednesday.

If at all feasible, make the sacrifice in your schedule to attend both on Holy Thursday and Good Friday to begin the Paschal Triduum.

This week, Confessions will be at St. Bernadette 7:00 PM on Monday and Wednesday until all are heard, with outside priests coming in and Examination of Conscience sheets available to help prepare you to experience the healing mercy of Jesus in a personal and transformative way through this Sacrament. The Easter Duty is every Catholic's obligation to make a Confession and Communion at least once each year. Please give a call to the office if you need a special time.

There is no 4:00 PM Mass Saturday; the Easter Vigil, the foremost liturgy of the year, brings our Catechumens and Candidates from RCIA into full communion with the Church through the reception of the Sacraments. Come to support them and experience a transcendent celebration.

For those who can't make it to the Easter Vigil, Masses for Easter morning will be the regular 8:30 AM in Bremen, and then at 10:00 AM and NOON at St. Bernadette. Going forward, the Sunday Mass will continue to be at 10:00 AM.

If it were not Holy Week, it would be the Feast of St. Bernadette this Tuesday. That observance gets transferred to the Monday after the Octave of Easter, April 29th, at which the school children will be present to celebrate. Join us!

Our Forty Hours devotion last weekend provided a great opportunity to turn the corner of Lent into Passiontide prayerfully. Thank you to all the adorers, especially who took those late/early nighttime hours. From the feedback, it seems like many would participate if we could offer more extended Eucharistic Adoration regularly, which is a sign of spiritual health in our parish!
