It's been great having Deacon Michal here at St. Rose. He's very happy at our parish and full of energy and joy in all that he does. Last weekend as you can see, was a busy weekend for him and was certainly the fulfillment of many years of hard work. As you are aware, the deacon is encouraged at the pastor's discretion to preach, to preside at wakes, marriages that are not a Mass, baptisms and burials. He assists the priest at

Mass and is invited to take on some sort of parish ministry. The role of Transitional Deacon is somewhat different from the role of Permanent Deacon in that the Transitional Deacon is being mentored and prepared for the priesthood. This past weekend Michal celebrated the burial rite for Rose Lamberti, baptized two little babies, preached for the first time at all the weekend Masses and presided at the Eucharistic Procession and Benediction. In the coming months I will practice privately with Deacon Michal to help prepare him in the celebration of Mass, Wedding Masses, Funeral Masses, confessions. I so appreciate all of your prayers and support of Deacon Michal during this most important year for him.

This Saturday of Memorial Day weekend Bishop Serratelli will ordain 10 men to the holy priesthood. Keep these young men in prayer as they begin their ministries in the parishes of our diocese late next month.

As we consider the beautiful feast of the Precious Body and Blood of Jesus, we consider that we too are the Body of Christ. As the Body of Christ (Christians throughout the world), we realize that we are linked through our common baptism to guide, support and pray for each other. I'm very proud of the food pantry we have here at St. Rose and thanks to your generosity we support those in our town and those in our surrounding towns who are in need. There are sadly many demands upon the churches in Passaic, Paterson, and Dover for non-perishable food, as many in the urban areas are finding it more and more difficult to pay rent and sustain themselves. As you know, Bishop Serratelli has asked every parish to assist those most vulnerable in our diocese by bringing non-perishable foods to each of the 111 parishes during this weekend of the Feast of Corpus Christi. Each parish has been invited to bring a specific item and our parish has been assigned canned soup. For your convenience we placed the white parish truck in front of the church last Thursday and it will be there until Tuesday. As you come to Mass please bring whatever soup you feel is appropriate and place it in the truck.

I look forward to seeing as many parishioners as possible at the Memorial Day Parade this Monday. As a great nation of freedom, we must never take our freedom for granted. If we look to the Middle East and North Africa, we see a lack of freedom and victims of violence risking life and limb to escape repression. For those of our lovely residents who are not at the shore this weekend, make every effort to make your presence felt as we celebrate this weekend of pride and loving remembrance we have for those who have served our country.

### Baptism

### Sacrament of Marriage

Please contact Fr. Owen or Fr. Mathew and set up an appointment. Any Catholic couple needs approximately a year to prepare for the Sacrament of Marriage, which includes sessions with the Priest celebrating the marriage and attendance at Pre-Cana conferences.

### Sacrament of the Sick / Hospital Visits

At St. Rose we are strongly committed to the spiritual care of the sick. Because of privacy laws, hospitals and nursing homes are not allowed to release the patient's religious affiliation. Therefore, we must depend on families of our sick parishioners to inform us of their whereabouts and condition. Please notify the parish office of any need for a home or hospital visit.
