Friday night, February 10th 6:30pm – 9:30pm

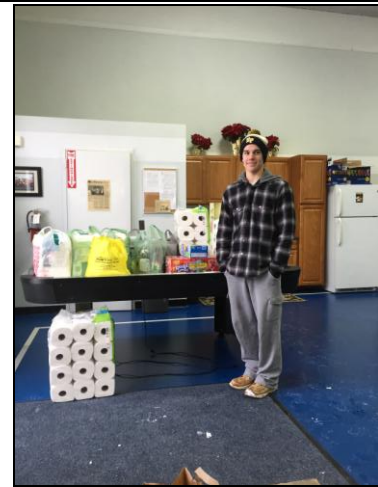

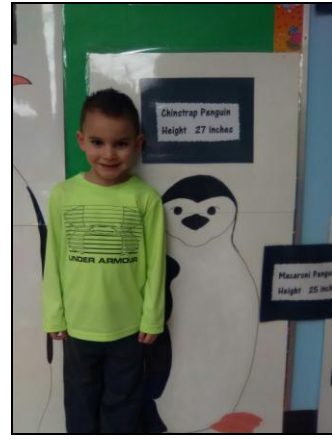
