*First Sunday of Lent March 5, 2017*

The two important aspects of Lent involve a journey through prayer and a journey through sacrifice so that we can be purified and made evermore open to the will of the Lord. Every year I try to take on a prayer experience and an experience of sacrifice because sacrifice without prayer has little effect. Again this year I am praying and meditating upon one Station of the Cross per day. I invite you to join me in this prayer experience. Every year until now our parish has sacrificed for a different charity. It was wonderful to hear Marissa Blackett's presentation last weekend. The plight of refugees living in and around Bethlehem is frightening. These people have no permanent home and feel unwelcome in the country their ancestors lived in for generations. As usual, I'm making a supreme sacrifice this year!!! You all know my big weakness is ice cream, which I will give up from Ash Wednesday until Easter Sunday. As usual I will put \$20.00 aside each week and on Palm Sunday we will have the collection to help support the Holy Family Hospital of Bethlehem Foundation. I encourage you to join me in this endeavor.

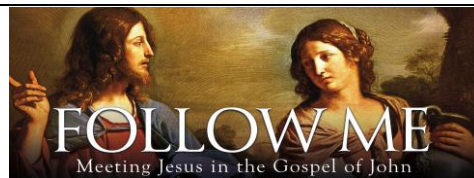

**LENTEN REGULATIONS**

**Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of FAST and ABSTINENCE:**

Those between the ages of eighteen (18) and fifty-nine (59) are obliged to fast, which means that only one full meal is taken on a day of fasting and no meat is to be eaten.

**FRIDAYS of Lent are also days of ABSTINENCE:**

The law of abstinence requires that no meat be eaten on a day of abstinence.

**Easter Duty:**

Is the reception of the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist. To fulfill this obligation the time period is from the First Sunday in Lent (March 5th) to Trinity Sunday (June 11th)

## Holy Family Hospital busy at work saving lives



Khawla and her husband Sami reside in a small village outside Bethlehem. Eight months into her pregnancy, Khalwa was diagnosed with gestational diabetes. Holy Family Hospital's Diabetes Clinic identified the condition during a routine prenatal exam. Almost 20% of the local population battles with diabetes, a disease that disproportionately affects women of a lower socio-economic status.

Khawla's pregnancy was now considered high-risk, and she was much older than she was during her first pregnancy. She had regular check-ups at the Clinic. After her delivery, baby Maria was immediately admitted to the Neonatal ICU for observation and was happily discharged after only two days.

"I am so grateful to Holy Family Hospital that Maria is healthy. The doctors monitored me and my baby after I was diagnosed and made sure we were both okay."
