Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time August 27, 2017



We gather this last weekend of August to celebrate the Lord's unconditional love for us. At this time many of us are happily away on vacation enjoying wonderful new experiences. Many are at the beach continuing family traditions started many years ago. For many of you your child has just begun freshman year in college and you're filled with a sense of excitement for your child and a sense of loneliness because they are living far from home. Many of you have brought your child back to college and are wondering how the summer went by so quickly.

Life is certainly about transition and as fall begins next month a sense of busyness will again invade our lives. In these last days of summer it is good to reflect on our relationship with God and how God empowers us to use our gifts with generosity.

In this week's Gospel we see Jesus teaching in the Roman colonized area of Caesarea Philippi. Jesus came to bring the Jewish people to him and also to give faith and hope to the Gentiles (pagans). Jesus didn't discriminate in those whom He called to faith. His life was an open book of invitation to all; old and young, rich and poor, Jew and Gentile alike. The Jewish people however expected that the Messiah would be from a noble family and they hoped that he would save them from the tyranny of the Romans. When Jesus asked the crowd who He was some replied that He was John the Baptist come back to life. Others believed He was one of the prophets of old who came to direct them to the coming of the Messiah. Jesus of course was and is the Messiah. He encouraged the crowd to open their hearts and minds to His message and to not procrastinate in following Him.

Simon Peter replied "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." The Lord Jesus then gave Peter (the first pope) authority over the other disciples and explained that he and the other popes who would follow after him would have authority for God's chosen ones. Our present Holy Father, Pope Francis, is exceptionally talented, incredibly bright, and filled with the humility necessary to lead God's holy people in this present difficult age. Looking back at the early Christian community we see that the followers of the Church built "Church" not only on authority but on family love and values. We here at St. Rose continue as beloved disciples on the journey.

As Catholics we follow attentively the guidelines of our church and reach out to many regardless of race, religion or background with the faith which we have been blessed with. We keep our young people in college in prayer knowing the foundation we have given them in faith will not only sustain them in life but will empower them to evangelize as did our mothers and fathers before us.

How blessed are we disciples of the Lord, challenged and yet guided by God to be His light in the world, His hands in the world. We pray that our feet will bring us in the direction of the Lord's calling.
