Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time August 19, 2018



This weekend we celebrate the 45th Anniversary of the founding of the Knights of Columbus in East Hanover. Council 6504 began in the kitchen and basement of the home of Vinny Leo on August 20, 1973. Vinny became the Charter Grand Knight of the new Council, with the support and encouragement of the then pastor, Father Bob Morris. With the assistance of Tom Dougherty, who was already a Knight from a different council and in collaboration with ten men of the parish, the council began with a total membership of 35 men.

Their efforts in the beginning were community projects that embedded the four Principles of the Order: "UNITY, CHARITY, FRATERNITY and PATRIOTISM." With that in mind the council built lean-to's for the Boy Scout Camp, (called Camp Thunderbird), funded by cutting down trees and selling the wood, and the Council started Boy Scout Troop 120. They then went on to fund and build the bandstand at Lurker Park.

The Council held carnivals, blood drives, square dances, and a Wives Appreciation Night. They also hosted spelling bees, free throw contests, poster contests, and essay contests.

During my time as pastor, the Knights have grown in great numbers as have their good works. We presently have 120 active Knights and 90 retired Knights. These strong Catholic gentlemen are the right arm of the Church. They support the needs of the Holy Father and the needs of their local community. Here at St. Rose our Knights are responsible for:

- Organizing and placing "One Nation Under God" flags around town.
- Our Knights, in coordination with our Rosarians, present a rose and a Rosary to each couple who present their baby for Baptism.
- They donate towards the support of the parish.
- They support the seminarian/seminarians with a small book stipend.
- Many of our Knights are Ushers and welcomers. Some are Readers and Extraordinary Ministers.
- Most recently, some of our Knights became catechists and assist in our Religious Ed program.

God bless those men, who 45 years ago, began the Knights of Columbus in our town. God bless those men who presently continue the good work.

Imagine Alex has now completed five years of seminary and has only one year to complete for ordination. We've all enjoyed having him with us for the summer. He leaves this coming Thursday, August 23rd, to return to seminary. Let us keep Alex in our prayers. We're thrilled that in five weeks time, on Thursday, September 27th, through the grace of God, he will be ordained a deacon by Cardinal DiNardo at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. Looking forward less than nine months towards Alex's priesthood ordination, please save the date May 11th for his ordination in our Cathedral in Paterson. Please also save May 12th at 12:00noon Mass which is the date, through the grace of God, that Alex will celebrate his First Mass here at his home parish.

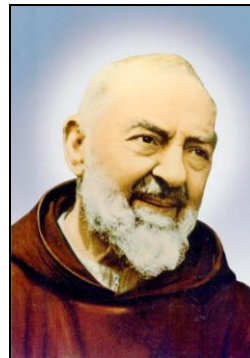
