In honor of the Lord's presence, our Sanctuary Lamp will burn this week, beginning November 6th, for the People of the Parish living and deceased.

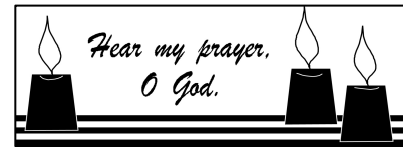

32nd SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: 2 Maccabees 7:1-2, 9-14

A king tortured a Jewish family, and tried to make them violate the laws. They all refused to give in and violate the laws. All of the family members told the king they would rather die at his hands than surrender their hope of being resurrected by God.

Second Reading: 2 Thessalonians 2:16 – 3:5

Gospel: Luke 20:27-38
