What is your Spiritual Charism?

To follow up with the Spiritual Gifts Workshop in October 2015, we will look at each of the Charisms presented. The first Charism is **ADMINISTRATION**. *The Charism of Administration* empowers a Christian to be an effective channel of God's wisdom by providing the planning and coordination needed to accomplish good things.
