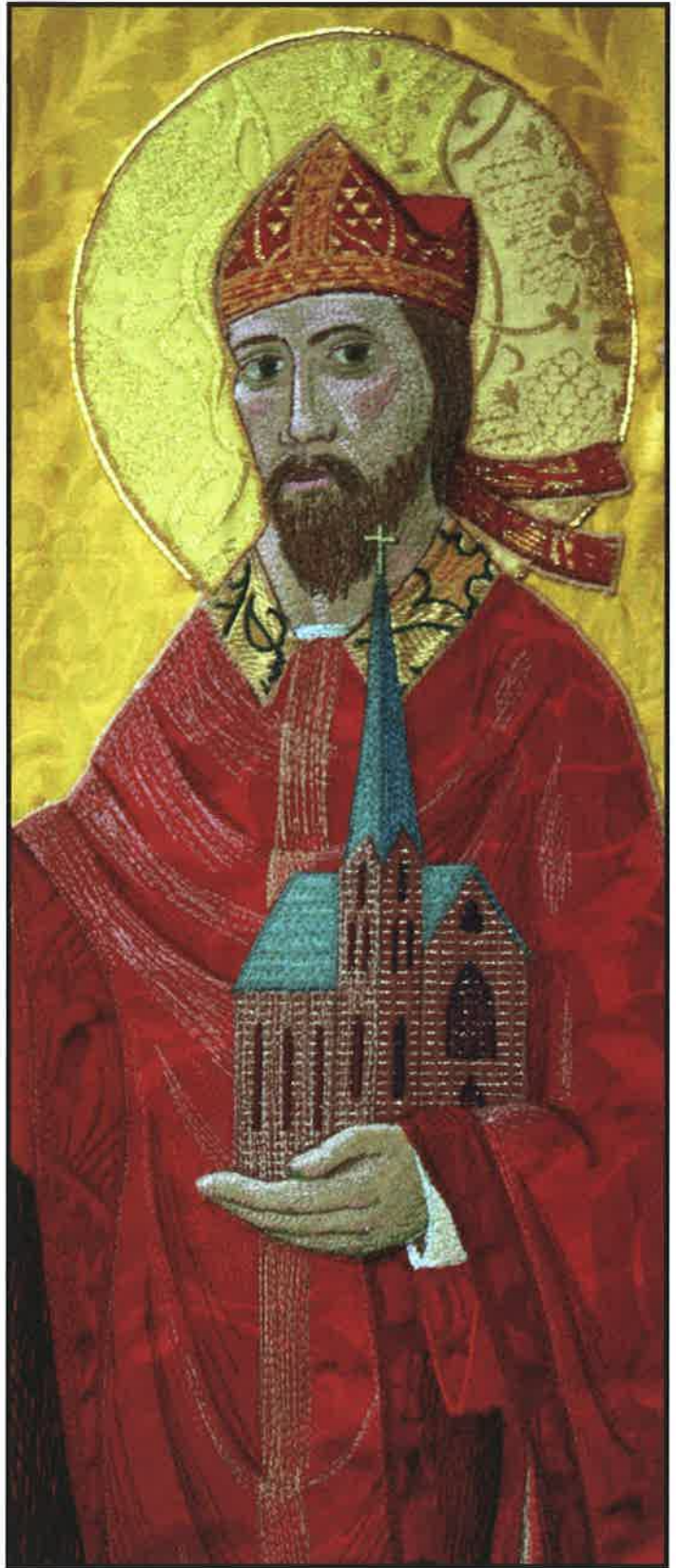

This is not only the Fourth Sunday of Easter, but April 17th is also the World Day of Prayer for Vocations.
