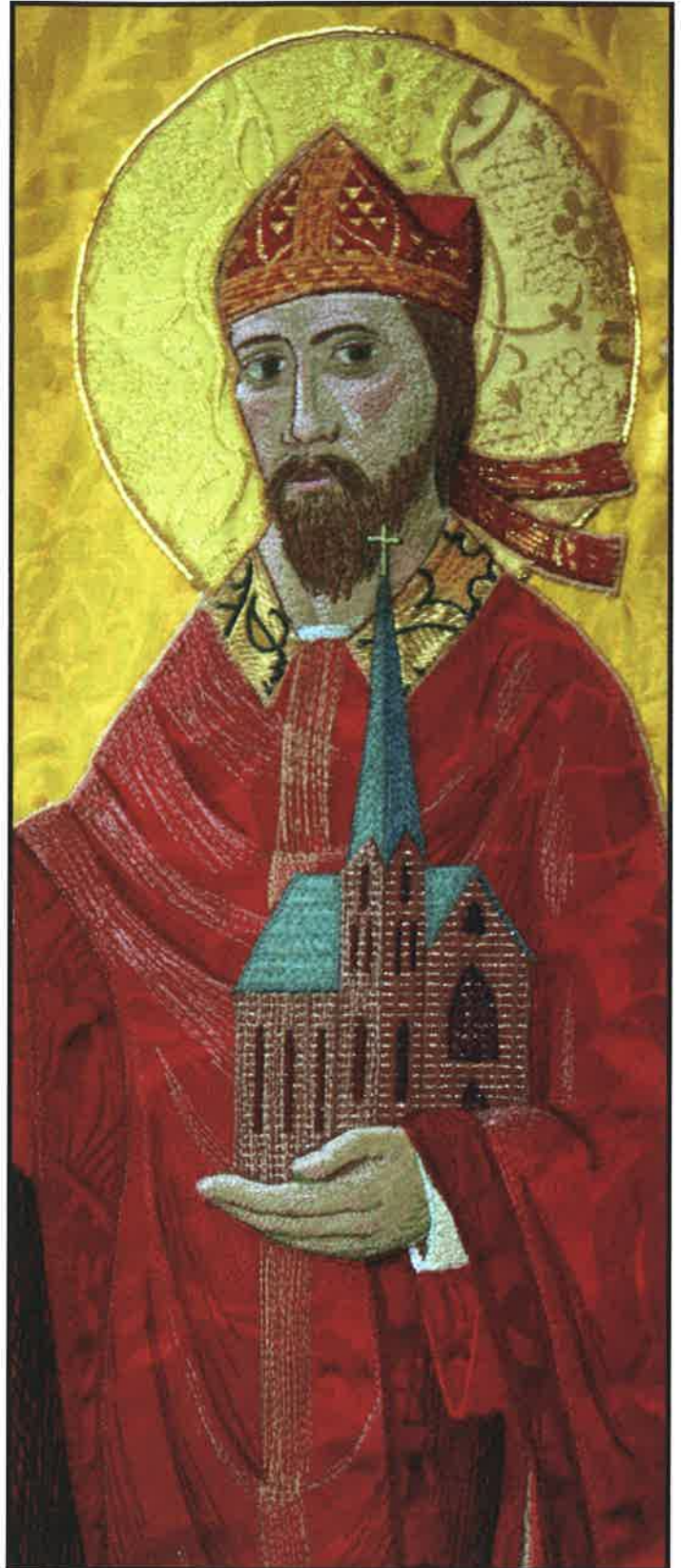

The fair committee would like to thank you in advance for the time and monetary support you are giving to the biggest, annual fund raising project we have in the parish.

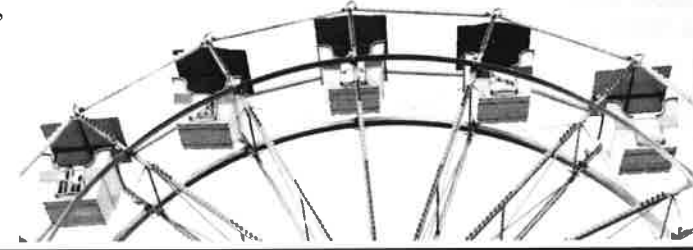
From the Parochial Vicar's Desk...

Let's support Daniella Straathof and her mission work with FOCUS

The "fastest-growing religious demographic in the US are people who list their faith as 'unaffiliated'" (The US Religious Landscape Survey) Daniella was very humble last week when she spoke about her mission work with FOCUS, a program held on college campuses (both Catholic and secular) that supports students and helps them live the Gospel while surrounded by varying lifestyles and challenges that the college atmosphere entails. More and more in today's society, our Catholic children are leaving the church – especially when they go off to college. Let's support one of our own who has chosen to serve as a FOCUS missionary and support students in the college setting who may be struggling with their faith. As a FOCUS missionary, Daniella needs approximately \$3200/month for the next two years (the term of her contract). She has to raise all of this money herself. FOCUS does not pay her a salary or assist with living expenses. While one-time gifts are certainly welcome, the monthly support that she referenced in her message last week is preferred so that she has continued support over the next two years at Ava Maria College in Florida where she is stationed. Won't you be one of these supporters?

New Security and Fire System Installation

Thanks to the generosity of our parishioners, we exceeded our BAA goal and can therefore upgrade the existing fire and security system in the church, parish hall and rectory. As mentioned in Father Hahn's Bishop's Annual Appeal correspondence, the funds collected over and above our BAA goal will be used in this manner. The new system by Silco is scheduled to be installed next week. With it comes some changes.

The most noticeable change is that the Parish Hall will be locked continuously throughout the day. Due to the increasing concerns of safety and security in the Diocese and in today's world, it was decided to follow suit with most other parishes and keep the building where the Parish Office is located locked at all times.

Another change will be that the church will now be unlocked during Parish Office hours, Monday-Friday, 9am - 1:00pm. This will allow our parishioners to have quiet time with our Lord outside of the Mass times.

You may have other questions like we did when looking at security systems. Below are answers to those questions you may have as the new system is implemented:

- How will I get into the Parish Hall?** There will be a camera and an intercom system at the side entrance in front of the Parish Office. The staff will be able to see who is at the door and can talk to you through the intercom system. There will be a release button in the Office to allow access to the building.
- How do we get into the Parish Hall if we have a meeting or an event?** The building will be scheduled to automatically unlock and lock at the designated times according to when you have the building scheduled through the Parish Office. This will hopefully prevent the common issue of the Parish Hall and church being unlocked overnight as it has been on several occasions.
- How do I get my event scheduled so that the building will be unlocked?** Contact Tina Garland in the Parish Office. The preferred way is to email her at office@stcolmanwch.org with your event details.
- I have keys to the Parish Hall and/or church. Will those keys still work?** No... Once those doors are rekeyed, your current key(s) will not work in the locks. Because of the electronic system, you will not need keys to access those buildings.
- I have keys to specific rooms in the Parish Hall and/or the church. Will those keys still work?** No... The rooms will be rekeyed as well. If you need access to a specific area, please complete a "Key Request" form found on the website under "Parish Information/Contact Us" pages. NOTE: We are ordering a limited number of keys for each room, so they will be distributed on a very limited basis.
- Will I still be able to exit the building in the event of a power outage with the electronic locks?** Yes. In the event the power goes out, you will still be able to manually exit through the outside doors.
- Why the change in fire protection?** By contracting with Silco, we are able to combine fire and security into one system that is less expensive on an annual basis than what we are currently paying to contract with Central Security and Chillicothe Fire and Safety.

Since this will be a big change for our community, more of the details and kinks will have to be ironed out. Watch the bulletin and website for more details as they become available. Also, "thank you" to David Finley for your assistance and support in "securing" (pun intended) this new system. You have been a tremendous resource!

Please know that these changes are not to prevent you from using your parish resources and space. Due to increasing safety concerns in our communities across the country, it is necessary to secure our buildings more than they are currently. We're doing our best to be proactive when it comes to building security and the personal safety of our staff rather than reactive. If you have questions, you may contact any of the parish staff members and clergy. Thank you again for your generous support of this worthwhile project!
