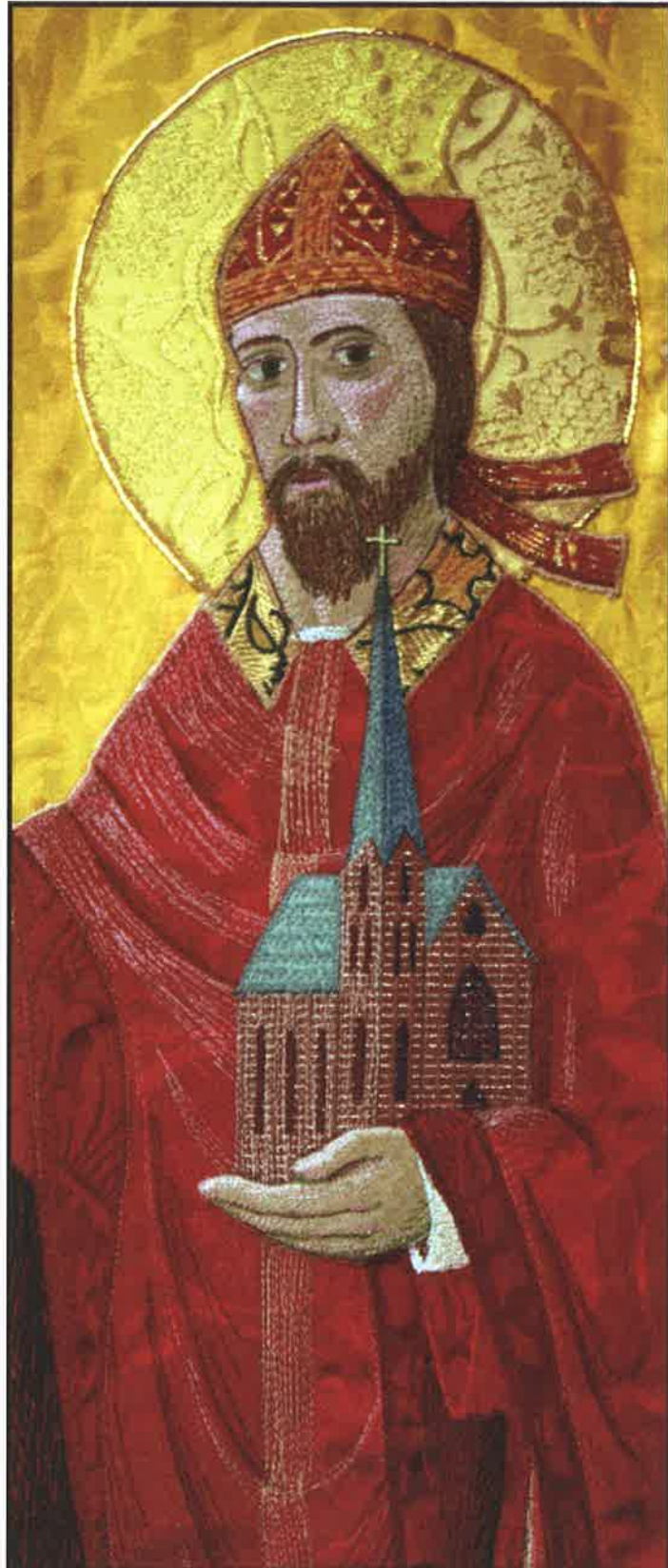

From the Pastor's Desk...


Please be sure to join us next Sunday evening as we celebrate our parish picnic. This used to be a staple of St. Colman life, and parish council and the priests thought it good to re-start. The picnic is meant to be a relaxed summer gathering of our parish family. The bulk of the meal is provided, all you need to do to get ready for it is bring a dish (see elsewhere in bulletin as to what kind of dish you should bring depending on the first letter of your last name). It would help us to know how much to prepare if you could sign up in the back of the church so we have an idea number-wise. There is no cost for the meal.

The picnic itself begins at 5:00 but we will start with Sung Vespers or Evening Prayer of the Church at 4:30p.m. in the church. This service is about twenty minutes long and we chant the psalms back and forth in the church and then listen to a brief Scripture reading and responsory, followed by an antiphon and sung Magnificat (Mary's song of praise recorded in Luke's Gospel). The service concludes with petitions, an Our Father, and final blessing. This is part of the "Liturgy of the Hours" - the set of prayers that all priests, deacons, and religious are required to pray daily and laity are encouraged to.

Also, thanks to all of you who worked the fair booth this past week. It is a great way to get in the midst of the community as-a-parish and to make some money for the church and the charities that the parish contributes to. Your hard work was definitely appreciated. I and Fr. Dooley had a good time working Tuesday evening. Fr. Hartge on the other hand, was noticeably absent - though he did go to the extent of circulating photos depicting him as though he were in Mexico on a mission trip. Fr. Dooley and I still have our doubts.
