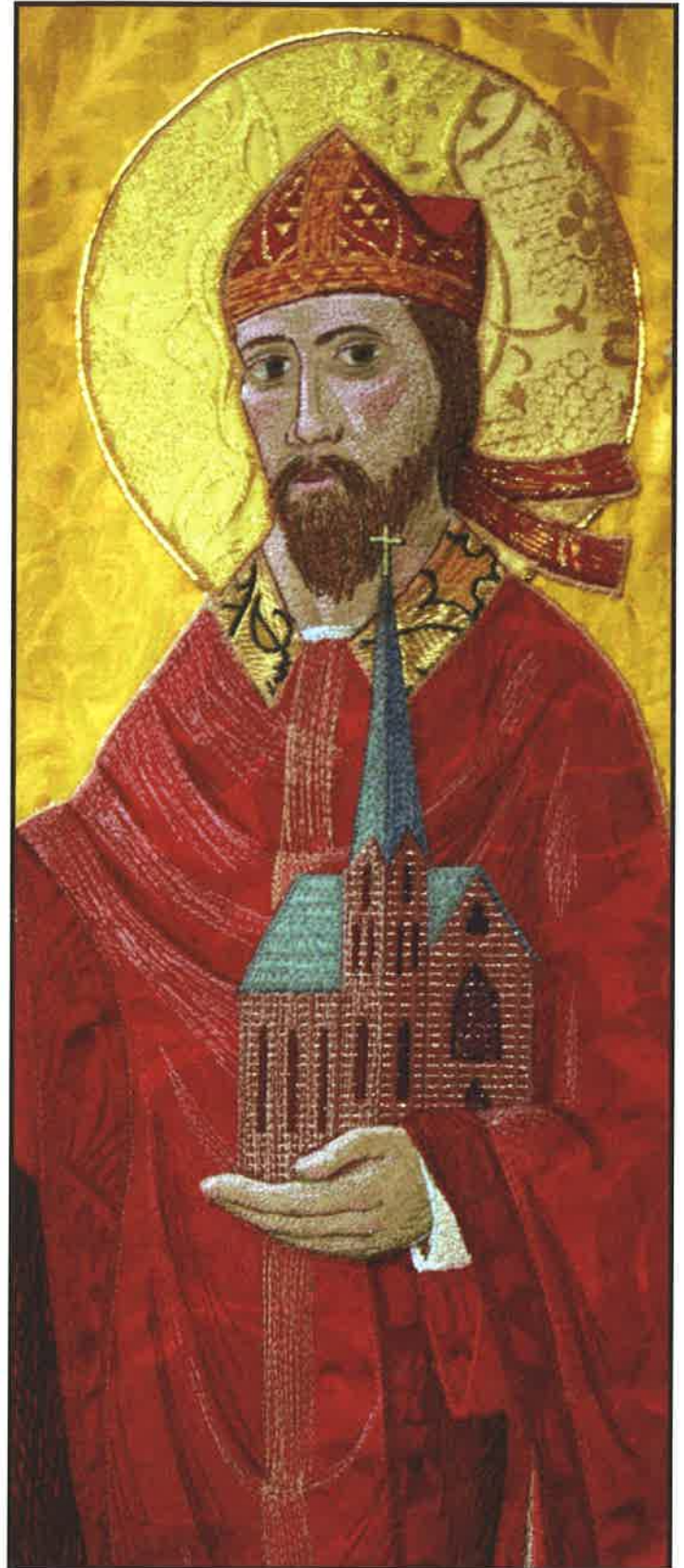

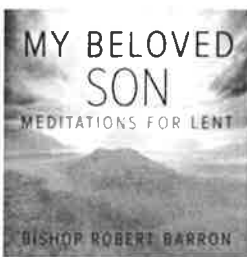

From the Desk of the Parochial Vicar...

Last week was the Rite of Sending of our Catechumens and Candidates in the Rite of Christian Initial of Adults (RCIA) Program. We have 3 catechumens and 3 candidates. A **catechumen** is one who is preparing for Baptism. The catechumenate is the formation of these catechumens in preparation for their Christian initiation, and aims at bringing their conversion and their faith to maturity within the ecclesial community, the church (CCC 1248).

Since we can only receive the sacrament of Baptism one time, those who have received valid baptism in another ecclesial community (Methodist, Lutheran, etc.) are called **candidates** for full communion. They are already joined to Christ in Baptism, and share that sacrament with us. So they are preparing to join in the full communion of the Catholic Church through the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil.

Please continue to pray for these 6 courageous souls who desire to join the Church and conform their lives more to Christ. As we were reminded in last week's Mass, let us live lives that reflect deep repentance of our sins and Faith in Jesus Christ so as to be the best of examples to those coming into the Church.

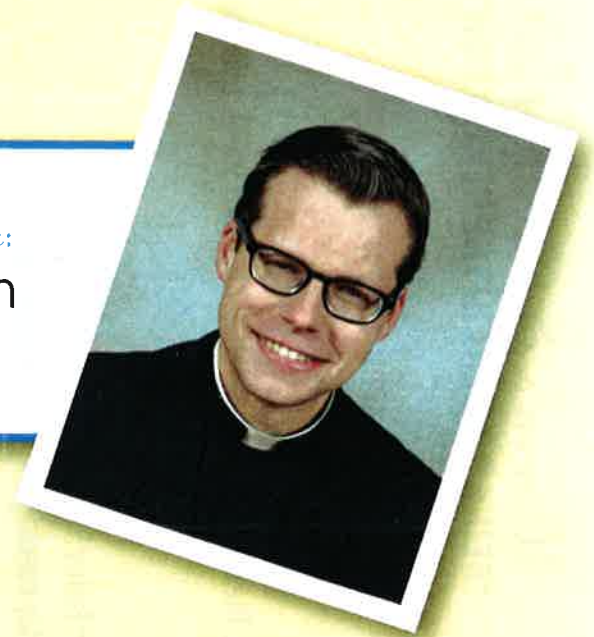
