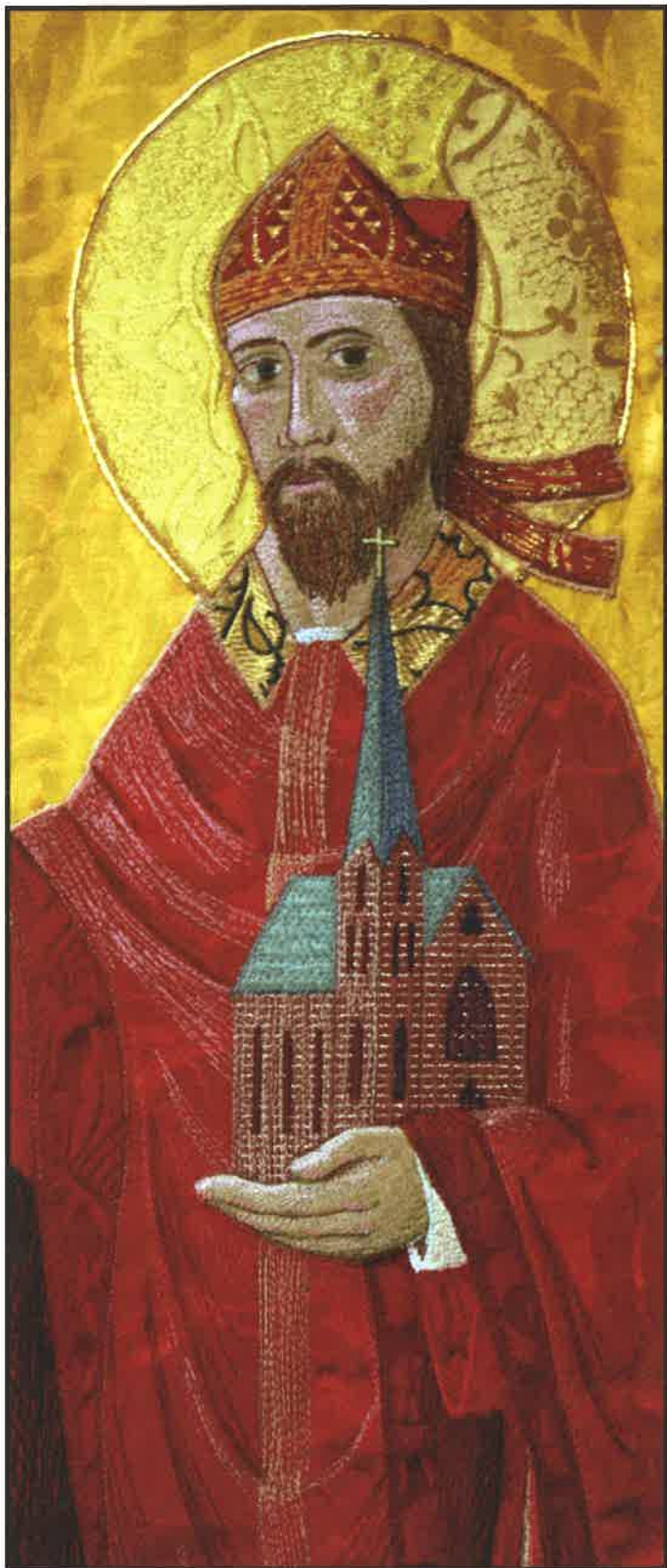

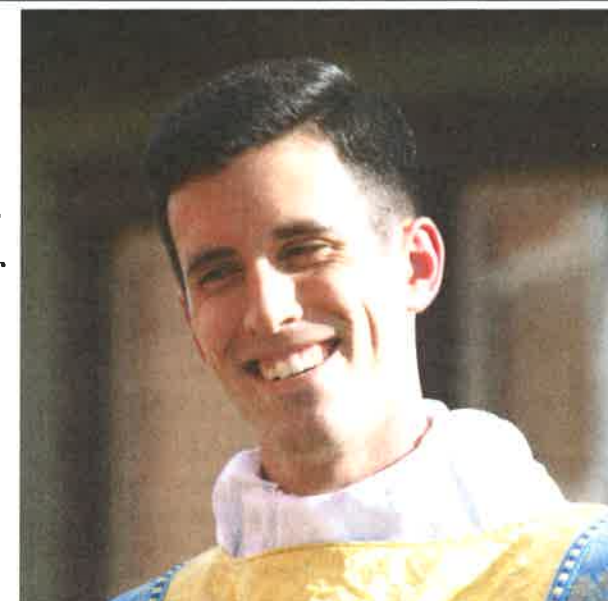

BISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL 2018 SHARING HIS LOVE, ENCOURAGING HOPE

Bishop's Annual Appeal

"Sharing His Love, Encouraging Hope", the theme of the 2018 Bishop's Annual Appeal inspires us, as people of Faith, to share the love that God has for us, which can often bring hope to those who might not have felt His love. Works of kindness and help, in sometimes the smallest way, can bring about a profound change in a person's life. Through the BAA, we have an opportunity to bring about a positive change in the lives of many of God's people. Through your generosity, you are supporting the various ministries and programs that are so vital in spreading His love. Our parish has been asked to raise \$29,279.31 from the Diocese. But since everything above our goal comes back to the parish tax free, Father Hahn has asked that we raise an additional \$10,000 making the total \$39,279.31. If every household gives \$350 (\$30/month), we will reach our goal and allow us to enhance the parish community with a quieting room behind the sanctuary, outside security cameras and upgrades to the parish library. We can accomplish this, after prayerful consideration, if everyone gives what they can.
