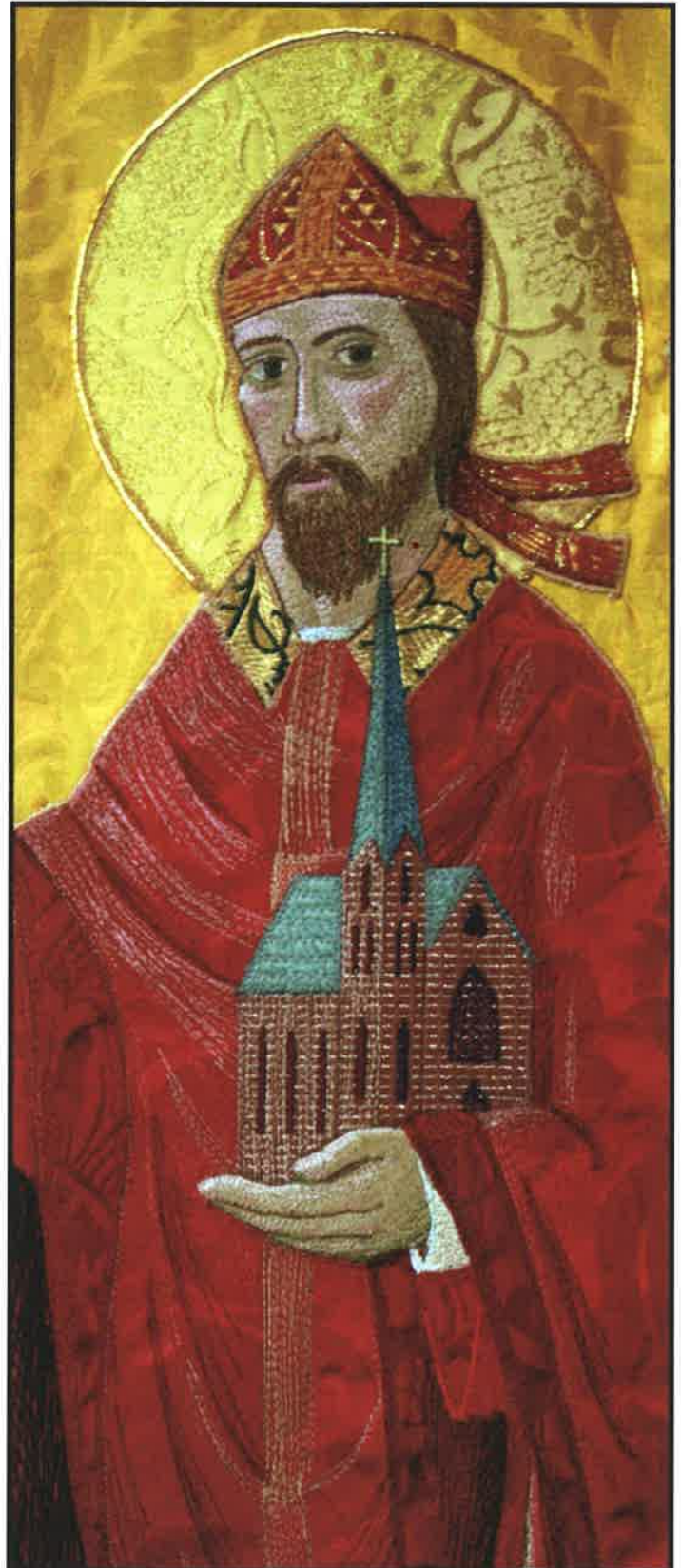

## Prayer Chain Update

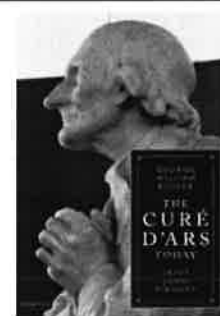

### Living the Liturgical Year

*Celebrating Saints and Feasts to Enrich Hearts and Homes*

**August 8: St. Dominic; patron of falsely accused persons, founder of the Order of Preachers (Dominicans)**

**St. Dominic** was born in Castile, Spain around 1175. He was known for his learning and love of poverty and founded the Dominicans around 1215. He and his friars were instrumental in crushing the Albigensian heresy which was ravaging parts of Europe at the time. Since penance was a focus of St. Dominic's preaching, we can celebrate today with a simple, meatless meal as an act of penance for our persecuted brothers and sisters.

### RECIPE: Simple Summer Spaghetti (from catholicculture.org)

(serves 4)

#### Ingredients:

- 2 medium tomatoes diced or 2 cups cherry tomatoes, halved
- 4 tablespoons (tbsp) extra virgin olive oil
- 1/4 cup each chopped fresh basil and flat leaf parsley
- pinch of dried red pepper flakes
- 1 pound dried spaghetti
- 2 medium zucchini, diced
- 1 large clove garlic, minced
- salt and fresh ground black pepper to taste

**Directions:** Place tomatoes, 3 tbsp olive oil, basil, parsley and pepper flakes in a bowl and stir. Season with salt to taste. Set aside for about an hour for flavors to develop. When tomatoes are nearly ready, cook spaghetti according to package directions. Heat the remaining tbsp of oil in a skillet over medium heat. Add zucchini and garlic and cook, stirring occasionally until zucchini is crisp-tender, 4-5 minutes. Season with salt and pepper. Drain spaghetti and transfer to a large bowl, add tomato and zucchini mixture and toss. Adjust seasoning if necessary. Serve warm or at room temperature.
