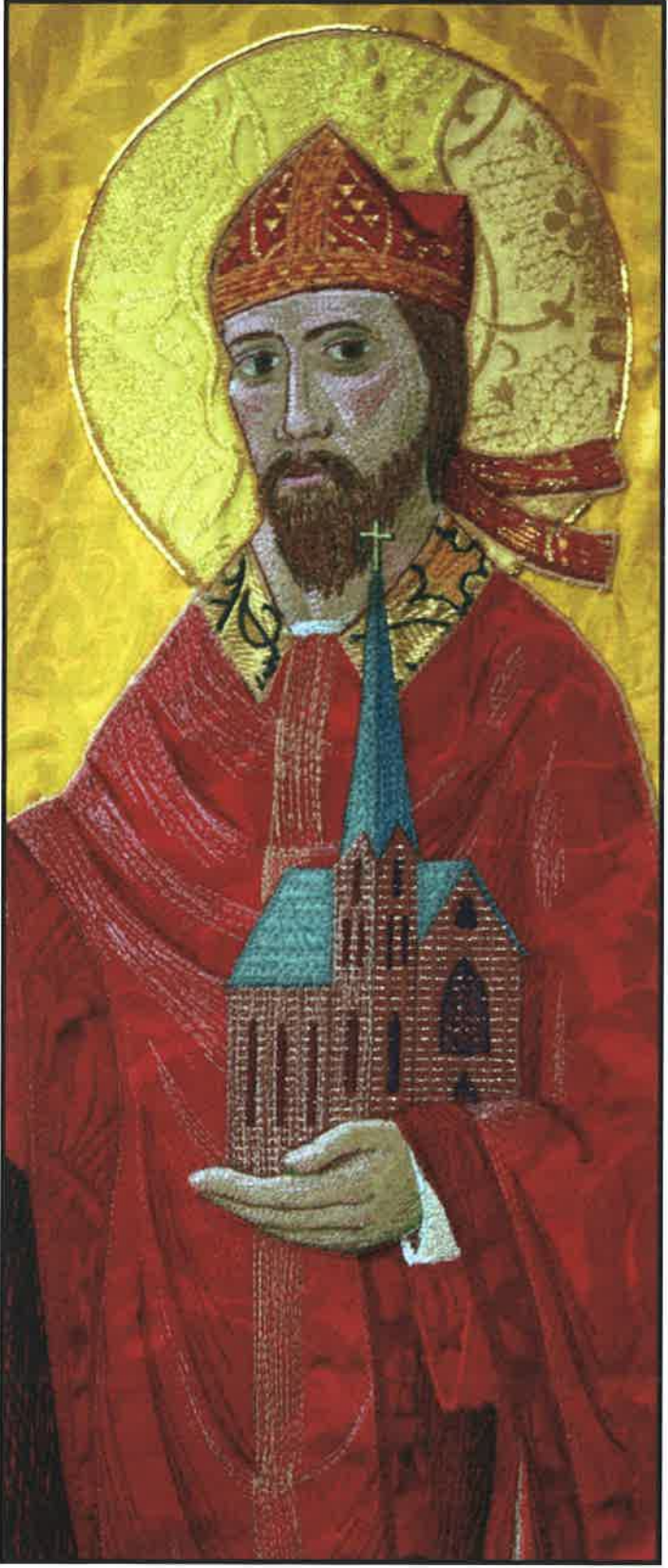

From the Desk of Fr. Dooley...

Next weekend during the Masses, we will be celebrating the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. This will be done across the Consortium and we planned it close to the worldwide celebration of the *World Day for the Sick*. Catholics eligible for the sacrament include:
[From the Instruction on the Pastoral Care of the Sick]

- ◆ A person who is seriously sick – the sacrament may be repeated if the sick person recovers after being anointed and then again falls ill or if during the same illness the person's condition becomes more serious.
- ◆ A sick person may be anointed before surgery whenever a serious illness is the reason for the surgery.
- ◆ Elderly people may be anointed if they have become notably weakened even though no serious illness is present.
- ◆ Sick children may be anointed if they have sufficient use of reason [are of confession age] to be strengthened by the sacrament.

After the Masses next weekend, Fr. Hahn will pray with anyone else wanting prayers (e.g., for addictions, minor illnesses, strength, faith, etc.). Please pray for those who face various illnesses and for the homebound of our area.

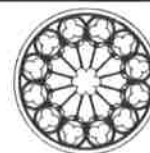

Living the Liturgical Year

Celebrating Saints and Feasts to Enrich Hearts and Homes

February 6: Sts. Paul Miki and Companions, martyrs

In 1597, in Nagasaki, Japan, 26 men were martyred for their faith in Christ. They were priests, brothers, laymen, artisans and even youth but they all died with joy. They were tied or chained to crosses and pierced with a lance. The charge was that they were from the Philippines and were leading the people astray. Paul Miki, however, was a Japanese samurai and Jesuit and preached to the executioners and spectators from the cross about this fact and about the truth of Jesus Christ. When missionaries were allowed back into Japan in the 1860's, at first they found no sign of Christianity. After establishing themselves, however, they found a thriving community of thousands Christians around Nagasaki. They had secretly preserved the faith for over 250 years! In honor of St. Paul Miki we thought we would have this quick ,easy Japanese sitr fry.

RECIPE: Japanese Stir Fry (from catholicculture.org)

(Serves 8-10) **Ingredients:**

4 boneless, skinless chicken breasts, cubed	1 green bell pepper, diced
4 carrots, cut into matchsticks	1 small white onion, diced
1 large head broccoli, cut to bite size	1 red bell pepper, diced
1/3 cup shoyu or soy sauce	1/4 cup sesame oil
1 tbsp sugar	2 tbsp rice wine
	2 tsp ginger

3 garlic cloves, minced

Cut up all meat and veggies so they are ready to cook. If you wish to have rice with it, start it now in the rice cooker or on the stove. Using a wok or a large frying pan, heat sesame oil over medium high. Add in garlic, then add in shoyu, vinegar, rice wine, sugar and ginger. Mix well. Add chicken. Cook until no pink, it will have a rich brown color from the sauce. Add in the veggies and cook until tender crisp. Serve over rice.
