
Dear Parents,

In 2002, the United States Bishops approved The Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People in an effort to protect children and youth from sexual abuse at all levels of church life. Article 12 of the Charter directs all dioceses to create programs to teach children and youth about sexual abuse and its prevention. In the Diocese of Fort Worth this program is integrated into the Catholic school curriculum, religious education classes, and youth ministry sessions.

The religion teachers for grades K through 6 will present the self-protection sessions during the first 30 minutes of FSR on November 4, 2018; the lesson will be presented to grades 7-12 on Wednesday, November 7, 2017. Grades K through 5 involve lesson plans and grades 6 through 12 involve a video. If you have a teen who wishes to volunteer with children, for example, as a VBS volunteer, they must attend these sessions as well as the Teen Leader Training offered later.

If you are okay with your children attending the sessions, simply check the "Yes" for each child on the back section of this letter and return it to the parish office, to the attention of Silvia Lesko, along with your Registration forms (if you do not return the form we will assume it is okay for your child to attend). If you do not want your child(ren) to participate, check "No" on the form. We will then make sure they are not in the classroom for the self-protection session. We will also send materials home for you to go over with our child. We appreciate your cooperation and support of this vital program.
