## Divine Mercy Minute:

St. John Paul II calls us to “**Be not afraid.**” We must not be timid or fearful of living a life of Divine Mercy. If we believe, after a moment of reflection and prayer, that the Holy Spirit is prompting us to do something, then we must not be afraid to act, trusting that God will use our sometimes flawed human actions and work through us. Our **YES** to God is a *yes* to others, and from that *yes* miracles can happen.

In life we can think that our actions are imprudent, but in fact the Lord might be asking a mighty deed of us. Think of Noah building an ark large enough to carry his family and two of every kind of animal safely through the flood (see Gen 7-8). Remember the little boy who shared his lunch with Jesus...who blessed it and fed thousands of people with it (see Mk6:34-44). When we step out and try to follow God’s lead, he will reward that trusting obedience---though we may not see all the ways the Lord uses us to accomplish his purposes in this lifetime.

When we offer mercy to others, we become Christ’s hands and feet in the world; in responding to his command to love our neighbor as we love him we will find the gospel peace he wants to give us.
